The NCLN is a community driven library/information resource centre located in Nakivale Refugee Settlement. The library has nearly 10,000 books stocked in various subject disciplines and a variety of toys and activities for children. The project liaises with Partners and sectors particularly in handling Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS), Sexual and Gender Based Violence (SGBV) child protection(CP), legal and education.
